## About the Composer


**Franz Schubert** - January 31, 1797 –November 19, 1828



Although he died at the age of 31, Schubert was a prolific composer, having written some 600 art songs, nine symphonies (including the famous "Unfinished Symphony"), liturgical music, operas, some incidental music, and a large body of chamber and solo piano music.

Appreciation of Schubert's music during his lifetime was limited, but interest in his work increased significantly in the decades following his death. Today, Schubert is seen as one of the leading exponents of the early Romantic era in music and he remains one of the most frequently performed composers. *—abstracted from Wikipedia*

## About the Music

Schubert wrote “Marche Militaire No. 1” for piano, four-hands, as a teaching piece. This, the first of three Military Marches that make up Schubert's Op. 51, is well established in the piano repertoire. It features an instantly catchy theme, an infectious sense of exuberance, and has a characteristic Schubertian quirkiness.

The main theme is quite playful and joyous. The middle section features some deftly wrought variants of the theme. And finally there is a return to the main theme.

Although written for keyboard, the music is so versatile that it has been fully embraced as music for wind band and for and full orchestra.

Stravinsky recognized the light humor in Shubert's work and quoted the main theme in his “Circus Polka,” written for the elephants in Ringling Bros., Barnum and Bailey Circus.
