About the Composer

P.I. Tschaikovsky (May 7, 1840 – November 6, 1893)



Peter I. Tschaikovsky was a Russian composer of the Romantic era. Born into a middle-class family, Tchaikovsky was educated for a career as a civil servant, despite his obvious musical precocity. He pursued a musical career against the wishes of his family. Although he enjoyed many popular successes, Tchaikovsky was never emotionally secure, and his life was punctuated by personal crises. Amid private turmoil Tchaikovsky's public reputation grew; he was honored by the Tsar, awarded a lifetime pension and lauded in the concert halls of the world. His sudden death at the age of 53 is generally ascribed to cholera.

Perennially popular with concert audiences across the world, Tschaikovsky has attained the status of a significant composer. —*Abstracted from Wikipedia*

Bill is the founding director of North Royalton Community Band in which capacity he served from 1998 to 2009. In addition, he has been coordinator, producer, composer and arranger for TubaChristmas Cleveland since 2002.

About the Music

Melodie, Op. 42, No. 3 is the third movement of the only work for Violin and Piano, written by Tschaikovsky, *Souvenir d'un lieu cher* (*Memory of a dear place*). The work was completed while he was on vacation in May, 1878. Based on Alexander Glazunov's arrangement (1884) for Violin and Orchestra, Bill Park created this setting for Alto Sax and Band.
